### Duke of Edinburgh Bronze Award for Year 9

The Duke of Edinburgh Award Scheme is the world's leading achievement award for young people, and is highly regarded by universities, colleges and employers. It encourages young people to develop independence, commitment, leadership and teamwork through being involved in a personalised programme of activities. Kimberley School fully supports the award and recognises its unique value for developing skills and attributes in young people. **Students in Year 9 are now being invited to apply for participation in the D of E Award Scheme at Bronze level.** The Award is split into four sections; volunteering, physical, skill and expedition. It takes approximately 6 months to complete and requires regular commitment to various activities. Kimberley School has asked The Mill Adventure Base (as part of NCC Outdoor and Environment team) to help deliver the expedition section of the D of E award for this academic year. The total cost of the award will be **£200** and once students are enrolled, any money paid is non-refundable. This will cover the DofE registration fee and all the training & expeditions for the expedition section including instructors, assessors and campsite fees. Some places have already been taken by Y10 students, but we would like to open the remaining 35 places to Year 9 students.

Year 9 students and their parents/carers who are interested will need to attend a **Presentation Evening on Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> November at 5.30pm** where the Bronze D of E Award will be explained in detail and questions answered. The meeting will be in the **Community Room**, which you should be able to access from the external door on the side of the school building. Students will then be invited to apply for a place and if successful, the core dates and format of the programme will be as follows:-

**Training residential weekend 24<sup>th</sup>- 25<sup>th</sup> March 2018 including overnight on the Saturday**

**Training walks day 29<sup>th</sup> April 2018**

**Practice expedition 19<sup>th</sup>-20<sup>th</sup> May 2018**

**Final expedition 16<sup>th</sup>-17<sup>th</sup> June 2018**

Participating students **MUST** be available and attend all of these dates.

We look forward to working with the staff and students of Kimberley School and hope to see you at the presentation evening.
