**Year 10 Mock Exams w/c 25/06/18**

Year 10 students will have formal exams from the week commencing the 25/06/18 (Maths Paper 1 will take place on 21/06/18). These exams will help inform us of the progress students are making alongside the normal assessments and tests undertaken throughout the year but will also help prepare students for the demands of the real exams that they will sit in the summer of Year 11. The GCSE exam system is now designed that everything is tested in a linear fashion i.e all assessment is completed at the end of Year 11. Students need to be fully prepared to cope with the demands of this system. Doing formal exams in Years 7-10 will help:

- Students to understand the demands of revising a lot of subject content
- Enable students to develop their revision skills
- Allow students to experience doing formal exams in the exam hall
- Give students the experience of undertaking several exams in a short period of time
- Enable students to improve their exam skills including timing and maximising how to gain marks on exam questions.
