Dear Parent / Guardian,

Re: Easter Revision

Year 11 pupils are now in the final two months of their G.C.S.E. courses. In each subject pupils are being prepared for their exams with revision sessions and exam question practice. As you are aware, all Year 11 pupils have been provided with a revision folder including an advice and guidance booklet about how to revise and a week by week list of topics to revise in each subject.

We have advised pupils that they should be aiming to complete a significant amount of revision over the Easter holiday period. To assist their preparations a number of staff have offered to come into school during the Easter holiday to run revision sessions for Year 11 pupils. Students were given the timetable of these sessions last week and a copy is attached to this letter. Please ensure that your son / daughter is aware of the sessions and arrives on time if he/she is aiming to attend.

A great deal of research has been done over the years to prove that a sustained period of planned revision can make a significant difference to a student's final grade. It is clear that many of the Year 11 students are well into their revision and this is very pleasing.
