

## Revising for the mock exams

English Language exam (2hrs 15 mins)	<p>Both the higher and the foundation paper have a question on language features. So, make sure you have revised <b>language features</b> (for example, simile, metaphor, alliteration, hyperbole, personification etc).</p> <p>You will be asked to write for a specific purpose (describe, inform, explain, persuade or argue), so revise the techniques you need to meet that purpose. For example: DAFOREST</p> <p>Use the English Language Revision book (available from the English department for £3.00) to support your revision. The first few pages of the book explain how the questions are worded and what you need to do to answer them.</p> <p>We recommend YouTube clips by 'Mr. Bruff' as another way of revising – but take notes as you watch!</p>
Media Studies exam (1 hour)	<p>The topic of the exam is 'Advertising and Marketing Films'.</p> <p>You should revise:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Media terms which help you to analyse a film poster</li><li>• Audience theories</li><li>• Wider marketing strategies</li></ul> <p>It is possible that you will be asked to design a film poster and explain how it appeals to the audience, so think about possible designs.</p>
