




There will be **no** Reading and Writing Club this Wednesday due to the Year 11 Parents Evening.

53535 and 51115 are examples of phone numbers that meet her rules..




Extension: What if Jennifer's number needed to be 6 digits long? What if she were allowed 3 different digits?



Meet in the LRC before heading to Kimberley Leisure Centre to get active and involved. **3.30-5.30pm**.


